# \*\*\* A Statewide STEMI System of Care for Iowa\*\*\*

#### Goals:

- Decrease the time of First Medical Contact (EMS) to PCI (cath lab)
- Develop statewide guidelines to improve the care for STEMI patients
- Provide funding for equipment to acquire and transmit 12-Lead ECG's
- Provide funding for software to receive 12-Lead ECG's at the hospitals
- Develop a reporting system for PCI Centers to give feedback to EMS and Referral Hospitals
- Provide education to EMS, hospital staff and providers across lowa regarding equipment, 12-Lead ECG and the guidelines
- Decrease mortality of STEMI heart attack victims in Iowa
- Provide high quality care to STEMI victims anywhere in Iowa
