- Joint EMS/Trauma/Preparedness conference Proposed Joint Conference in 2018. Will not do a combo this year possibly 2018. We have some suggestion. Trauma system docs are really excited to work with IEMSA to do a conference. Some really great ideas even if it's not until 2018. It was a very open group. They'd like to do a collaborative, multi-disciplinary Track. So it's not just adding a track. With the time we have we should be able to grow our conference and combine resources. In the meantime we might tap some of their people to come in for this year. Diane Williams will work with Katy on speaker contacts.
- **Time Critical Conditions** application is out and getting applications. Next round of questions out next week with next round of questions due February 1, 2017. Be sure your services are completing applications.
- Michelle Fisher Short moved to Field Coordinator filling Evelyn Wolf's position. Margo McComick comes from Omaha, starts
 on February 1th as Field Coordinator. Fiscal Coordinator position is filled by Steve Poole. Position at department of services—
 hope to have it filled soon.
- AMANDA system registry rolled out at the end of last month. There are glitches to the process. Working on cleaning up the

 renewal is now in full swing. Had some glitches—got most of those fixed now too. Steve

Approval of Minutes

- December 15, 2016 Board of Directors Meeting Minutes 1st Brad Vande Lune, 2nd Jerry Ewers Approved. Motion Carries. <u>Lobbyist Report --</u> Michael Triplett –
 - 2017 in session for 11 days and there are some funnel deadlines to keep in account. Tax bills or appropriation bills are exempt from the funnel deadline.
 - Senate File 62 fireworks Bill Strongest advocates in republican caucus is now an independent. So we have less influence
 - **Texting While Driving** States with this law have it as a primary law. Iowa has it as a secondary offence many have it as a primary offense law. There are all different views on this issue. We are in favor of all three as long as we are making it safer. Working on the language—there will be some change.
 - Senate File 96 Children under the age of 18 to wear helmets when operating ATVs. Motorcycle groups are worried this is the first step to 'everyone has to wear a helmet".
 - House File 17 Athletic Events—Football, Soccer and Wrestling. If you are there as a contact sport health official doing a job as a HC provider and you have a concussion victim. You have to be in touch with the parent and the home team coach or contact. Concussion protocol should be followed. If you're not responsible—if you are off duty, we'd like to get us not responsible for contacting parents that should be the athletic director's responsibility. Officials are trained to recognize the signs of a concussion—and the official has to inform the coach to take out the game. Officials then file a report with the State. Concussion victim have to take a post-concussion test—to clear them to go back on the field. Healthcare providers are there for treatment and transport and then clear them to come back in. Athletic Trainers can also clear to go back. Athletic Trainers are trying to relieve themselves of the notification.
 - Senate File 100 --Prohibits Use of Mobile Phones all together. There need to be some room for emergency type calls.
 - Medicaid/Medicare Reimbursement Rate Increase— Mike Triplett is In conversation with Sen. Costello and Rep. Dave Heaton on the HWMC, House Ways and Means Committee to try to persuade them to get this done for us. Not going at this as a bill, just having some good conversations with those on the appropriations committee to talk about increasing Medicare/Medicaid rates increases to a more rational level. Also talking to them about an increase in the Tax credit, however, because the budget is so tight—it's going to be tough. Some are thinking we get rid of a lot of tax credits etc. to increase monies for other programs.
 - EMS as an unfunded mandate is going to be tough. There are lots of mandates in place that don't need to be—and those funds would be better used for EMS and other public safety services. We need to seek out Farm Bureau Counties to partner with us to get this done.
 - Red Light Camera Proposal to eliminate the use of these. We have been asked by another group if we'd support apposing this. Mike Triplett recommends that we don't get involved in this in any way. Register Neutral. If we get in the middle of that—we'd be in the middle of lower speed limit, helmets for everyone etc. We just need to stay out of traffic control issues all together. Increased size of commercial transportation vehicles. A representative wants to meet with us to get our support.

- Approval of the 2017 Budget- Gary Merrill 1st, Brad Van DeLune 2nd Approved. Motion Carried.
 - Brandon Smith went through each line item noted the following items:
 - Scholarship Draw Down -- \$6000 / year (\$1000 for each region) over the next 10-years
 - Red Flash Group Contract How to start improving our public relations and education about EMS. Public Outreach Campaign to educate the public about who we are and what we do for them. Help the public understand who is delivering the EMS in their area—and how they can support those services.
- The E-Board worked very hard to figure out how to get a balanced budget. Specifically Jerry and Linda picked up where the budget meeting left off to get the budget balanced.
- Discussion Credit Card Processing is very high. But invoicing is more costly with labor and we lose a lot of revenue, with the invoices NOT paid.
